**Public Art Design Council  
Minutes – November 9, 2017  
City Hall – Executive Conference Room**

1. **Call to Order** –Kari Mailloux (V. Chair) called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Present: Patrick Calvillo (new member), Justin Combs\*, Jim Heck, Jana McCarron\*, Larry McLain, and Jim Seitnater\*. Patrick Calvillo was introduced as a new member. He is the interim Director of the Hutchinson Art Center. Teresa Ooton Preston arrived later. Absent: Charles Johnson (Chair), Lovella Kelley, Mark Rasette\*. (\* Ex-Officio with voting privileges.)

2. **Oral Communications by Audience** – No audience.

3. **Approval of Minutes for September 14, 2017**

Seitnater made a motion to approve the minutes, which was seconded by Combs and passed unanimously.

4. **Reports**

- A. **Percent for Public Art Projects:**

- **Sports Arena Public Art, and Fire Stations #3 and #5** are closed.
- **Fire Station #5 & Orchard Park** – No further update.
- **Main St. Streetscape** – Dye spoke with sculptor Kimber Fiebiger who reports that the sculpture titled “H.D.” has been completed and is crated for shipping or delivery. Fiebiger has offered to cover the expense of shipping or delivery in either April or May. If Fiebiger makes the delivery, she offered to make needed repairs to “Egghead” which was damaged by vandalism.
- **Otter Exhibit** – Dye and Combs presented a proposal to send out a second Call for Artists with this one calling for Reno County mural artists to paint portions of a concrete wall at the new exhibit. Entries could be reviewed and final selection made at the Design Council meeting on January 11<sup>th</sup>. Combs showed architect’s drawings of the exhibit. The mural would be painted in spring 2018 following construction of the exhibit. The 1% for public art is \$3,750.

McCarron made a motion to pursue the Call for Artists. Seitnater seconded the motion, and the motion pass unanimously.

- **Zoo Education Center** – This 2019 project has a revised estimated construction budget of \$200,000 with the 1% for public art figure at \$2,000.
- **Rice Park Splash Pad** – Dye reported on City Council action on October 3<sup>rd</sup> on the Design Council’s recommendation to purchase “Good Morning Sunshine” by Reven Swanson for placement at the splash park. City Council tabled the matter for 90 days to allow time for private fundraising of \$3,300 to match the 1% for public art amount of \$3,000, for the total purchase price of \$6,300. Seitnater said a private donor has indicated interest in contributing the entire \$3,300. Seitnater and Dye will meet with the donor for follow-up.

- B. **SculptureWalk Update** – Dye said possible donations from three sources to support SculptureWalk for next year amounts to \$3,750. However, an estimated total of \$15,000 would be needed for the

one year loan program with the current structure. If the program continues, a call for artists should be issued by December or January at the latest. Discussion was had whether to pursue additional donors and about concerns for future program sustainability. It was suggested to place the program on hold for at least a year and to wait for community feedback.

Heck made a motion to table both action items for the Rice Park Splash Pad public art and SculptureWalk. Seitnater seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

C. Mural Project Updates

The **SW Bricktown Mural** by Jocelyn Woodson is still in progress along the underpass of Woody Seat Freeway along Avenue A west of Adams. The **Boys & Girls Club Mural** by Brady Scott is completed. The mural is located outside the building of the Boys & Girls Club, 600 W. 2nd. The **Avenue A Park Mural** by Julie Black is on hold until next spring. Combs and Dye have removed the ramp from the project's art spaces since this is a service ramp that will have mowers and other heavy equipment crossing it regularly.

- D. Chamber ART Gallery – Dye said local photographer **Larry Carver** has provided framed photos for the new exhibit in the City Council Chambers and the Council Conference Room. The exhibit runs through January 29<sup>th</sup>. Entries are due December 29<sup>th</sup> for the next exhibit that starts February 5<sup>th</sup>. 5. Unfinished Business – None.

6. New Business – Dye said Leanne Cox of the Convention & Visitors Bureau is in the process of producing the new Visitors' Guide, which will feature some public art. Dye purchased advertising on behalf of the Design Council using the Hutchinson Public Art logo, and has assisted the CVB in selecting some of the art that will be included.
