SculptureArtWalk update report for Public Arts Council meeting Nov. 12, 2020 3:30pm

Sept 12, 2018 Meryl Dye gave the Public arts council a balance of Public Art Funds.

Downtown Public Art cash balance was \$13,035.50 This account is for general expenses and maintenance related to the City's permanent public art collection.

- Installations (pedestals, plaques, lighting, etc)
- Cleaning and repair
- Deaccession
- Insurance deductibles for lost/stolen/damaged art

SculptureArtWalk cash balance was \$3075.51

Tony Finley has asked for the remainder of SculptureArtWalk donated money be transferred to the HutchRec Foundation for use by SulptureArtWalk committee to continue with SculptureArtWalk 2021. Justin Combs has asked that the cash balance from 2018 remain with the city for maintenance etc. of permanent public art collection.

After 2020 SculptureArtWalk expenses the cash balance for SculptureArtWalk was \$7,173.45 on Sept. 16, 2020. If \$3,075.51 is to remain with the city the balance of \$4097.93 will be transferred to Hutch Rec Foundation.

SAW fundraiser 2020 brought in \$2100. Make It Great grant was received from HCF \$2500. After expenses were paid the balance for SAW in the HRF is \$2361.

When all monies are together SAW will have \$6458.93 to begin 2021 SAW

A yearly fund-raising budget was suggested to Tony by the committee.

Next expense for SculptureArtWalk will be plaques for existing sculptures. Apollo engraving has quoted the metal frame at \$40. each. The engraved plaque to be placed in the frame would be \$15. for each sculpture each year.
