
KANSAS YANK DIES OF FLU

**Sergt. Harold Brighton Was Son of
Quenemo News Publisher.**

Ottawa, April 5.—(Special)—The death of Sergt. Harold Brighton, of Independence, this week at Camp Zachary Taylor, Ky., after an illness of influenza and pneumonia for six weeks, is the ninth death in Company K, 137th infantry. Sergeant Brighton was a son of H. E. Brighton, editor of the Quenemo News, whose family still lives at Independence. He was sent back to the states, arriving just after the armistice was signed, going to Camp Funston, as bayonet instructor and later to Camp Taylor. He was a former employe of the Prairie Oil & Gas Co.
