

## MOORE CONFESSED.

HIS WIFE NOW ASKS THE COURT  
FOR A DIVORCE.

Hutchinson, Kan., Aug. 16.—This morning a petition for divorce from John A. Moore was filed at the district court by W. H. Lewis, attorney for Mrs. Mattie E. Moore. Mrs. Moore has returned from Lansing. She has so far refused to talk about her husband farther than to say that she wants to avoid hearing his name. The grounds for divorce in the petition are merely a statement of Moore's conviction of killing their children.

Mr. Franklin, Mrs. Moore's father, is convinced that Moore confessed all to his wife, and that she up to the time of his confession had believed him innocent in spite of all proof to the contrary. It is probable that in time Mrs. Moore will consent to make a statement regarding the matter.
