How Trees for Tomorrow Funds Help Hutchinson

The Hutchinson Tree Board has established the Trees for Tomorrow Fund to increase the planting of trees in Hutchinson's public areas, including parks, entry roadways, streets, around schools, etc.

Trees for Tomorrow contributions will add to Hutchinson's beautification through trees. Funds will be used for tree planting, tree education, and tree related community improvement projects — all dedicated to beautifying Hutchinson.



What is the Hutchinson Tree Board?

The Tree Board is a volunteer citizens group appointed and monitored by the Hutchinson City Council. The board's seven volunteers, Hutchinson Parks Superintendent and Hutchinson Senior Forestry Technician are dedicated to improving Hutchinson with trees.

Tree Board projects include a Tree Cost Share program to encourage homeowner tree planting, tree workshops and talks for the public, support of the Dillon Nature Center Arbor Day education project for city 4th graders, school tree planting projects support, and establishment of the Trees for Tomorrow Fund through the Hutchinson Community Foundation.

Recognizing Donors and Honorees

Honored individuals and Trees for Tomorrow Fund donors will be recognized by a leaf bearing their name appearing on a Tree for Life mural located in the Hutchinson Public Library. Leaf colors denote donation ranges:

- Green leaf \$ 100—\$ 499
- Bronze leaf \$ 500—\$ 999
- Silver leaf \$ 1,000—\$4,999
- Gold leaf \$ 5,000 or more

Regardless of donation amount, the donor will receive an acknowledgement of the tax-deductible gift from the Hutchinson Community Foundation (HCF) and the Hutchinson Tree Board. The honoree or family will receive a card acknowledging the donor and gift amount from the Tree Board.

Trees for Tomorrow Fund donations will be used for planting trees to beautify public places rather than for a specific tree. Your contribution may pay for part of a new tree planting or for several trees, depending on amount.
