

Supervision and User Responsibility

For City Owned Facilities

- The City reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time upon notice to the user and the user agrees to forgo any claims against the City for damages by reason of this termination.
- You should contact the Park Department at 620-694-1900 for permission to use electricity or water.
- The facilities are designated no smoking areas. No alcohol or liquor is allowed at the facilities.
- It is unlawful for any person to play, use or operate on the streets alleys, or public grounds of the City a loud speaker or sound amplifier without a sound permit. The sound permit may be granted or refused at the discretion of the City Manager.
- The user agrees to use the premises for lawful purposes and not to attempt to charge a fee or to sell any merchandise without written consent of the City Manager.
- Please leave the facility at the agreed time. The agreed time includes setting up, tearing down and cleaning time. Return tables and chairs to their original location prior to leaving. Leave the facility clean. Do not alter any equipment or buildings
- Assume responsibility for supervision of all persons at the facility and provide adult chaperons (age 18 or older) for any group that includes minors, one adult for each 15 minors.
- Assume liability for damage to facility or premises, which is in no way limited by the amount of the deposit.
- No pyrotechnic devices of any type are allowed.
- In the event the facility is in use and the party refuses to leave, call 911 for assistance.
